Pastor's Message

"...you are dust, and to dust you shall return." (Genesis 3:19)

Vice President: Wayne Earthman Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

March is a month of transitions. We "spring forward" from standard time to daylight savings time. We move from winter into "official" springtime at the vernal equinox, as the daylight, at last, grows longer than nighttime.

This year, we also transition in liturgical seasons in March, moving from time after Epiphany into Lent, from the vision of Jesus shining in glory on the mountaintop in his Transfiguration, to the dust and ashes of our own mortality and need for repentance, beginning on Ash Wednesday. Lent is our journey with Jesus down the mountain, as he sets his face toward Jerusalem and the cross. In our baptism we have died with Christ, and we

rise each day to live in him, and during our midweek Lenten services we will reflect on "baptismal living." I hope you will join us for these times of word, song, prayer, and reflection, and fellowship in soup supper afterwards.

Murphys Irish Day is coming up, our biggest fundraiser of the year. It is always a joyful day of working together and greeting visitors coming to our community. This is an event where everyone can help, whether baking, sitting at a table of goodies, or directing traffic.

Our Sierra Central Valley Conference Assembly will be on March 8 on Zoom. As the Conference Dean, I will be leading this assembly, and I'm very excited about our speaker, Regina Banks from the California Lutheran Office of Public Policy. I will send the Zoom link to all of our members, and everyone is welcome to attend.

I am continuing with visits to everyone in the congregation, although I have slowed down the pace. I love hearing your joys, hopes, concerns, and suggestions for our life together as Faith

Thank you to all who attended the congregational meeting on February 2. A budget of \$102,614 was passed, including hiring a bookkeeper and a yard maintenance worker. The projected deficit of \$15,799 will be covered, as needed, by taking principle from the funds from the sale of the parsonage. Mike Skenfield, Kathleen Walsh, and Susi Lewis were elected to serve on the nominating committee. Part 2 of the congregational meeting will be held in May.
